ONTARIO REFEREE CLASSIFICATIONS

A **Class 4** Referee may officiate soccer in the youth recreational divisions only.

A **Class 3** Referee may officiate in amateur soccer at the Youth or Senior levels.

A **Class 2** Referee may officiate in any category of amateur soccer and as an assistant referee in non-amateur soccer.

A **Class 1** Referee may officiate in any category of amateur soccer, or if recommended, act as a referee or as an assistant referee in non-amateur soccer and inter-provincial games.

CANADIAN SOCCER ASSOCIATION

A **Nominated National** referee is a Class 1 Referee who is selected by the Province to be considered for National status by the CSA.

A **National Referee** may officiate any level of game nationally, including non-amateur and inter-provincial games.
